

Access to Himeji

Conveniently located, connecting with major cities

Located in southwestern Hyogo Prefecture, Himeji City has an extensive transportation and logistics infrastructure with railroads, roads, and ports. It is a key transportation hub with links in all directions to the Keihanshin, Chugoku - Shikoku, and Sanin regions.

Himeji Station is served by Shinkansen, JR local and private railways. Urban functions are concentrated around the station, which plays a central role in the economy and society of the Harima area. Nozomi Shinkansen stop in Himeji, providing easy access from major cities in Japan and making it the "gateway to Harima." Its excellent location is one of Himeji's greatest

appeals and is a major drawcard for visitors.





With Nozomi Shinkansen, Arcrea HIMEJI can be accessed from Tokyo Station in as little as 3 hours and 10 minutes



A covered walkway provides stress-free access to the venue from Himeji Station

A covered walkway leading from Himeji Station connects directly to the 2nd-level west-side entrance of Arcrea HIMEJI via Casty 21 Park which is located to the west of Arcrea HIMEJI. This means visitors can access Arcrea HIMEJI from the station without getting wet and without getting lost. The lush, green Casty 21 Park further enhances the emotional uplift for visitors as a safe, comfortable and attractive pedestrian space. The walkway leads as far as the Hyogo Prefectural Harima-Himeji General Medical Center (HGMC), which is located on the east side of Arcrea HIMEJI.












Medium Hall








Exhibit Hall

- Highly versatile and open space can be used for exhibitions and various other purposes
- Can also be used for closed events by partitioning off the west side with curtain rails
- Exhibit Hall C features a large, permanent 500-inch screen
- Equipped with power supply and water supply and drainage pits
- Can be used in combination with the adjacent Outdoor Exhibit Space (The Outdoor Exhibit Space can also be used when raining)

The large pillar-free Exhibit Hall – with an area of about 4,000 m, a width of about 100 m, and a ceiling height of about 10 m – can be partitioned into three parts to be used flexibly according to the scale of the event






Meeting Rooms



The area around Himeji Station, including Arcrea HIMEJI, features a variety of sightseeing spots where you can experience spectacular natural scenery, history, and culture, including the Himeji Castle World Heritage Site. For corporations, academic groups, and other organizations, the Unique Venue HIMEJI Plan is also available for reception parties, commemorative ceremonies, conventions, conferences, product launches and other press conferences, and exhibitions.











World Heritage Site and National Treasure

Himeji Castle

In 1333, Akamatsu Norimura (Enshin) built the first fort on top of Himeyama Hill. This was subsequently added to by Hashiba Hideyoshi, Ikeda Terumasa, Honda Tadamasa, and other feudal lords, who all had dreams for a castle, until the present form of Himeji Castle (Himeji-jo) was completed in 1617. The castle is also affectionately known as the White Heron Castle because of how it looks against a blue sky and is likened to a white heron flying out of the water.

In 1993, Himeji Castle was registered as one of Japan's first World Heritage Sites in recognition of the following points: "the degree of its aesthetic perfection reaches the highest point in Japanese wooden architecture, and is unparalleled anywhere in the world"; and "it is the finest example of Japan's unique castle architecture with ingenious devices for protection, with the castle keeps, gates, earthen walls, stone walls, moats, and other structures well preserved from the peak of castle construction at the beginning of the 17 th century." In 2015, the preservation and repair of the main keep was complete, and the shining white plaster walls that are the hallmark of Himeji Castle are again on display for all to enjoy.



With the Himeji Castle World Heritage Site as its backdrop, this Japanese garden features paths around a central pond, and was opened in 1992. Visitors can enjoy nine different styles of gardens as they pass through the gates and walls.



This red-brick museum stands in a magnificent setting on a special historic site, looking up at the Himeji Castle World Heritage Site, which is commonly likened to a white heron.



Located in the northwestern part of Himeji City, Engyoji Temple is a Tendai sect temple that was founded by Shoku Shonin in 966, and is also known as the "Hieizan of the west." The temple is also famous as a filming location for movies.
